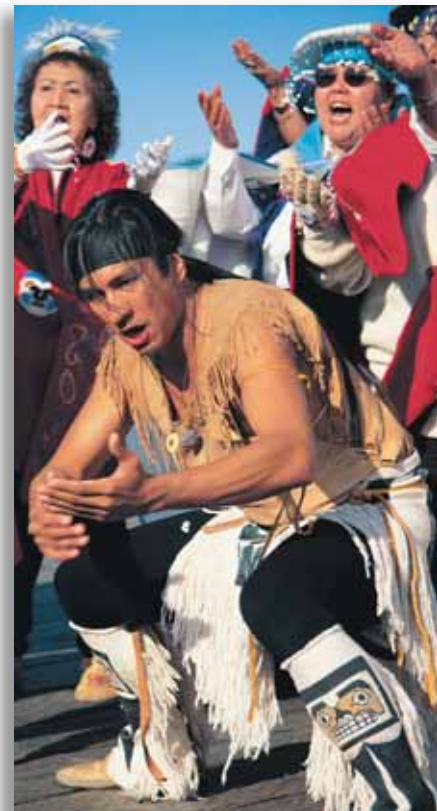
Juneau can deliver all of what Alaska offers and then some.

IT'S EASY TO GET HERE.

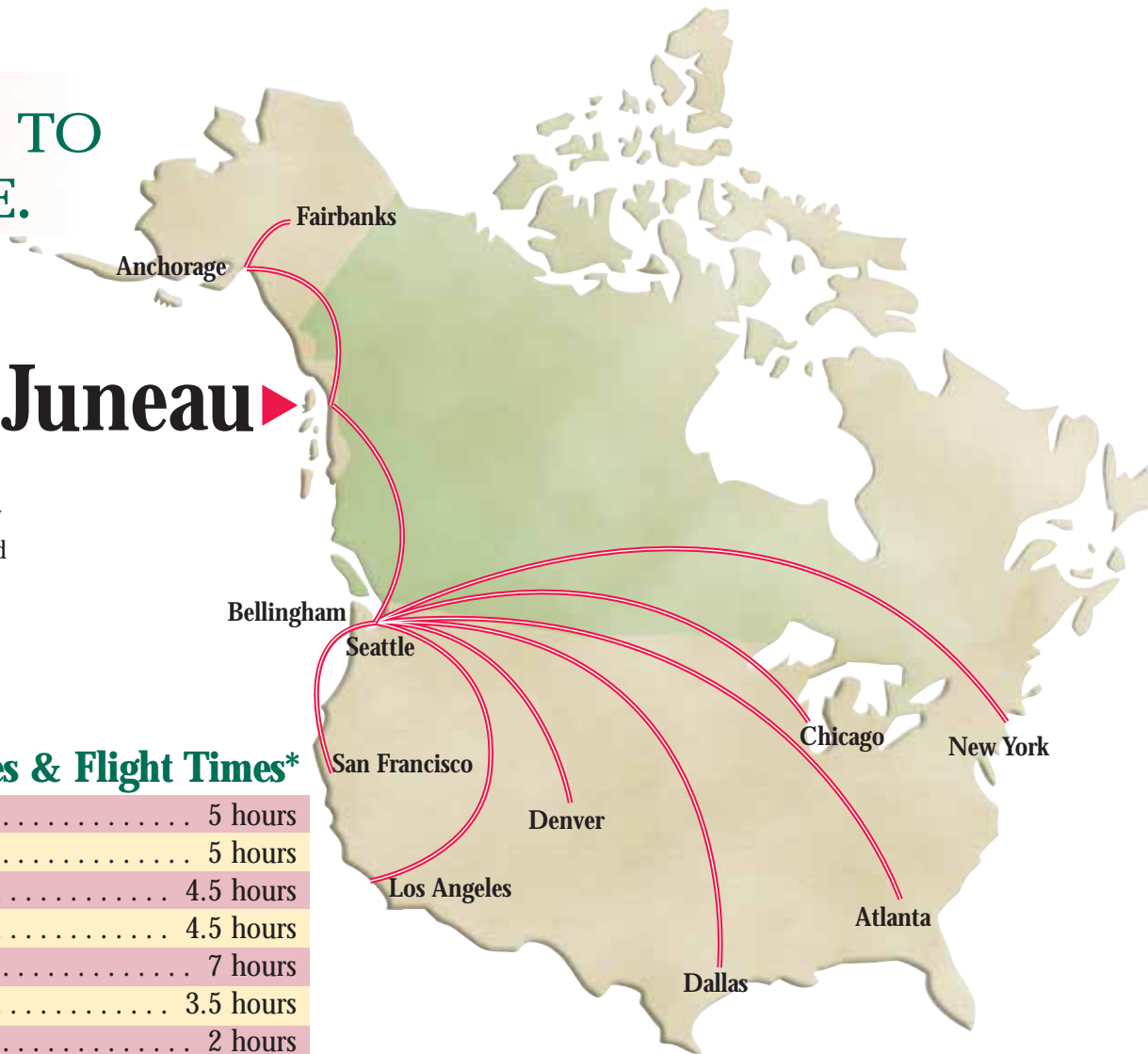
- Juneau is two hours by jet from Seattle and about an hour and 30 minutes from Anchorage.
- Juneau is served by Alaska Airlines year-round with an average of 18 flights per day from May to September and 9 flights per day from October through April.

The State of Alaska is located in the Alaska Standard Time (AST) Zone, which is one hour behind Pacific Standard Time (PST) and four hours behind Eastern Standard Time (EST).

JUNEAU FUN FACTS

- Juneau is the largest capital city in the US based on square miles.
- Juneau has just over 30,000 people and 20,000 bald eagles.
- Juneau has less than 200 miles of road, but more than 250 miles of hiking trails.
- Juneau has over 280 species of birds, three species of whales, all five species of salmon, black bear and the largest concentration of brown bear in the world.
- Enjoy the spectacular Aurora Borealis or “Northern Lights” October through May.
- Juneau is the only capital city that is solely accessible by marine vessel or aircraft. It is regularly serviced by the Alaska Marine Highway system, Alaska Airlines and several smaller commuter airlines.
- Juneau supports a symphony, an opera company, a lyric opera company, a professional theater company, a university and more.

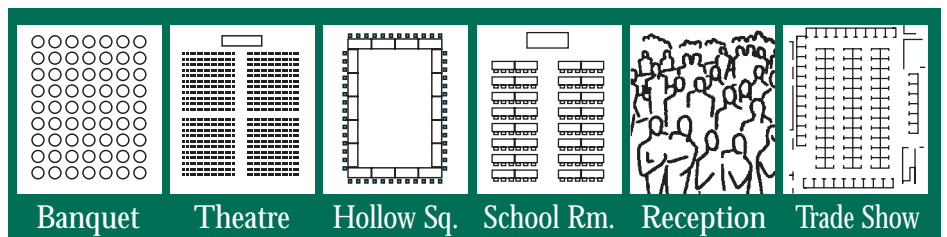
